DOUBLE ELIMINATION TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All teams make the play-offs.
2. All regular season rules apply.
3. Players must have played in at least three regular season games.
4. Teams will be responsible for finding out when and where their next game will be held.
5. A toss of a coin by the umpire before the game will determine the home team. Home team will receive the game ball.
6. **IMPORTANT:** All non-regulation games (not having played 4-1/2 innings) called because of rain or darkness will be rescheduled at the earliest possible date. In some cases the game will be scheduled for the following day, or days or the upcoming weekend. Non-regulation games that are rescheduled will resume from the point of stoppage. **Have your team prepared.**
7. Requests for schedule changes will not be considered.
8. A team found using an illegal player in the tournament will be disqualified from the tournament.
9. Driver's licenses will be checked at tournament games when required by the league director or umpire.
10. Team and individual awards will be presented to the champion and runner-up in each tournament.
11. The league director will rule on any situations not covered in the rules.
12. **All rain-outs will be made up the next day, or days, or on the upcoming weekend.**
13. In the final game, there will be no time limit or mercy rule. Seven innings must be completed.
14. Be prepared to pay the umpire \$20.00 before each game.
15. Serious injuries sometimes occur in connection with athletic activities, and participants exonerate the Neighborhood Club, its employees, and volunteers for any liabilities in connection therewith. The Neighborhood Club does not provide individual accident insurance. It is strongly encouraged that participants seek a doctor's approval before participating in an athletic activity.
